The Makin' Tracks Program recognizes WMHA MEMBERS for time spent in a saddle or in a horse-drawn cart. For a fee of \$5.00 per year, you can track your hours on any horse, and you'll receive cool awards at the levels outlined below. Logsheets are available at www.wmhaclub.com or may be obtained by contacting WMHA.

You must turn in your logsheet by September 30 to receive awards at the WMHA Annual Banquet.

You must be a WMHA member for each year hours are logged or your hours will be lost with lapse of membership. The calendar year for ride/drive time will begin on October 1 and end September 30.

Hours will begin accumulating from date of annual payment if not received prior to October 1.

Time that WILL count toward merit awards are: **non-competitive trail rides, arena or ring work, riding lesson hours, and saddle time spent on your horse or driving time sitting in the cart with the horse in motion.** Time that WILL NOT count toward merit awards are: **time spent in the show ring, on competitive endurance rides, or grooming time.**

MERIT AWARD LEVELS: 1st Merit: 75 Hours, 2nd Merit: 150 Hours, 3rd Merit: 300 Hours, 4th Merit: 500 Hours, 5th Merit: 1500 Hours, 6th Merit: 2000 Hours, 7th Merit: 3500 Hours, 8th Merit: 5000 Hours. Members accruing in excess of 5000 hours will be accorded a lifetime Makin' Tracks Membership.

Points are earned at WMHA approved shows in the following divisions:

Dressage, Driving, English Pleasure, Halter, Hunt Seat, Jumping, Saddle Seat, Trail, Western Pleasure.

Jackpot and Championship classes do not count toward points.

Points are tabulated according to the current Year-End High Point System.

Awards will be distributed at the WMHA Annual Banquet when the horse reaches the following point levels:

1500, 3000, 4500, and 6000 points.
